NoCo businesses chosen by NASA for potential contracts

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Proposals from Loveland-based Numerica and Colorado Power Electronics of Fort Collins have been selected by NASA for negotiation of possible development contracts.

The program will help businesses explore technological potential while providing the incentive to profit from new products and services. The partnerships formed will bring space technologies to the marketplace while creating jobs and providing assistance to startups and meeting NASA's mission needs.

Statewide, 11 businesses were selected by NASA for negotiations.

In addition to those in Northern Colorado, businesses chosen include: Tech-X, SPEC, ColdQuanta, Eltron Research and Development and GeoVisual Technologies, all of Boulder; Composite Technology Development of Lafayette, Genova Engineering and TDA Research of Wheat Ridge and Vescent Photonics of Denver.

Throughout the United States, 300 proposals worth approximately \$38 million were selected.
